## ITINERARY / PROGRAM

### DAY 01 MANILA/ ZURICH

Depart Manila on board a prestigious airline on your way to Zurich, Switzerland. Enjoy in flight meals and services.

### DAY 02 ZURICH – LUCERNE (D)

Arrive in Switzerland! After immigration and customs in Zurich you will be met by our representative. Transfer to the charming town of Lucerne for check-in and overnight. During your free time, you may walk along the famous Chapel Bridge and enjoy the Lake Lucerne or you may opt to do shopping for famous watches, swiss knives and chocolates!

### DAY 03 LUCERNE – MUNICH (ABF, D)

Drive to Munich, capital of Bavaria. Stop and view the stadium built for the 1972 Olympics and Marienplatz, with its fascinating Glockenspiel clock. We then visit Nymphenburg Palace formerly the summer residence of the rulers of Bavaria. Check-in at hotel for dinner and overnight.

### DAY 04 MUNICH-PRAGUE (ABF, D)

Enjoy a panoramic countryside drive as we cross the German & Czech border. Arrive in the capital, Prague and visit the Church of Our Lady of Victory to venerate the famous Sto. Nino de Praga. We walk to the Old Town Square to see the Astronomical Clock before checking in at our hotel for dinner and overnight.

### DAY 05 PRAGUE (ABF, D)

Morning guided visit will be at the impressive St Vitus Cathedral in the grounds of the 1,000 year-old Prague Castle. See the Old Royal Palace, St George Basilica, Daliborka Tower and the Golden Lane. Spend the afternoon as you wish.

### DAY 06 PRAGUE – DRESDEN – WROCLAW (ABF, D)

We drive towards Wroclaw via Dresden, known in the 18<sup>th</sup> century as the 'Florence of the north'. See spires, soaring towers and domed churches. Cross the Polish border and arrive in Wroclaw for dinner and overnight.

### DAY 07 WROCLAW – WARSAW (ABF, D)

See the large Market Square, the impressive 13<sup>th</sup> century Town Hall, bordered by renovated burghers houses, the historic Opera House and the Cathedral of St John the Baptist. Later, we drive to Warsaw, the Polish capital.

### DAY 08 WARSAW (ABF, D)

Admire Warsaw's historic center including the Old Town during your sightseeing tour with an expert local guide. See the 'wedding cake' Palace of Culture and the Chopin memorial in the Lazienki park. Pay your respects at the emotive Monument of the Ghetto heroes and, finally, visit Wilanow Palace, a priceless testimony to the splendor of Poland's past. Rest of the day at leisure.

### DAY 09 WARSAW – CZESTOCHOWA – AUSCHWITZ – KRAKOW (ABF, D)

First stop is to Czestochowa to visit the 14<sup>th</sup> century Monastery of Jasna Gora, famous for the Black Madonna, said to have been painted by St. Luke. Then to the city of Oswiecim, better known throughout the world by its German name, Auschwitz, the most infamous site of the Holocaust. We visit the concentration camp, a sobering reminder of the atrocities of World War II. The drive to Krakow for dinner.

### DAY 10 KRAKOW (ABF, D)

Full day sightseeing to one of Poland's oldest city and for centuries the seat of Poland's king. We visit the Wawel Castle and walk through the Old Town, past the courtyard of Jagiellonian University and medieval Cloth Hall towards the 14C St Mary Church. We also drive to Lagiewniki to visit the Shrine dedicated to Sister Faustina for private prayers and devotion. Dinner at a restaurant.

### DAY 11 KRAKOW – WADOWICE – VIENNA (ABF, D)

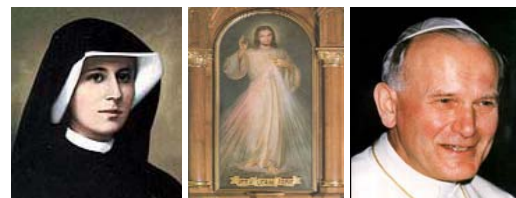
Stop in Wadowice to visit the Cathedral and see the house of Pope John Paul II before continuing to Vienna for overnight.

### DAY 12 VIENNA/ MANILA (ABF)

This morning we visit the Schoenbrunn Palace then continue your tour by driving around the famous ring road, the grand boulevard, Opera House, magnificent Hofburg Imperial residence and parliament building. Some free time before your transfer to the airport for your flight back to Manila

### DAY 13 MANILA

Arrival in Manila. Home sweet home!
