## ITINERARY

### Day 01 Manila/ Mexico City via Los Angeles

Depart Manila on board a prestigious airline to Los Angeles City. After immigration formalities, flight to Mexico City.

### Day 02 Mexico City (B, L, D)

Upon arrival in Mexico, you will be met and transferred to hotel. After breakfast, Visit the Metropolitan Cathedral and the Zocalo. Then visit the Plaza de las Tres Culturas, The square contains the remains of Aztec temples and is flanked by the Catholic church of Santiago de Tlatelolco. Drive to the Basilica de Guadalupe. A mass will take place here. This is the holiest shrine for millions of Mexican. Rest of the day is free.

### Day 03 Mexico City (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel. Basilica de Guadalupe, A mass will take place here. Also visit the Capilla De Las Rosas and Capilla Del Tepeyac. From here, proceed to San Juan Teotihuacan to inspect the awe-inspiring pyramids of the Sun and Moon and walk down the Road of the Dead to the Citadel, to wonder at the extraordinary Temple of Quetzalcóatl, with its stone-sculptured plumed-serpent heads. Lunch at restaurant then return to Mexico City, where the evening is free for individual activities. Dinner and overnight at hotel.

### Day 04 Mexico City – Cholula – Puebla (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel. Proceed to Cholula, the town of 365 churches- one for every day in the year, so the saga goes that is also the site of Mexico's largest Pyramid, still fully covered by weed and topped by a Catholic church. Drive over a modern highway, affording breathtaking vistas of the rugged Sierra Madre mountain chains. Arrival in the historical city of Puebla for a comprehensive tour that includes the stately, impressive Cathedral, and the historical forts of Guadalupe and Loreto, where Napoleon III's Imperial French Army was defeated by the poorly armed Mexican troops under General Zaragoza. The downtown area has preserved a strong Spanish-French flavour, and boasts an impressive number of historic and cultural monuments and buildings, including the exuberant, baroque Rosary Chapel and San Francisco Church. Countless constructions in the characteristic poblano style of bricks-and-tiles contribute to the city's particular physiognomy. Lunch at restaurant from hotel Colonial. Dinner and overnight at Hotel Colonial.

### Day 05 Puebla - Ocotlan - Mexico City (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel. Drive to the neighboring state of Tlaxcala and its similarly named capital city. A visit to San Miguel del Milagro. This is the site of miraculous apparitions of St. Michael the Archangel to Diego Lázaro in 1631, and of a well of curative waters. Outside of this charming provincial town we visit the Shrine and Sanctuary of Our Lady of Ocotlán, where an apparition is said to have occurred to Juan Diego Bernardino in 1541. Tradition has it that the Virgin left her statue in a burnt tree, as a proof of her apparition. But apart from its religious significance, the Sanctuary of Ocotlán also represents one of the high points of Mexican baroque art, its gleaming white stucco façade being a classical example of the Churrigueresque style. Lunch at a local restaurant. Drive to Mexico City and visit once again the Basilica de Guadalupe. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Mexico City.

### Day 06 Mexico City – Los Angeles (B)

Early Breakfast at hotel. Departure transfer to the airport for flight to Los Angeles City.

Arrive in the "City of Angels". Meet and greet with transfer to your hotel. Rest of the day is free.

### DAY 07 Los Angeles (Disneyland) (B)

Breakfast at hotel. Morning transfer for a full day at Disneyland, "The Happiest Place on Earth". Go on a magical journey in a kingdom of fantasy filled with family friendly rides, shows and attractions combined with dining and shopping that only Disney could create.

### Day 08 Los Angeles – Las Vegas (B)

Breakfast and check-out at hotel. This morning cross the Mojave Desert on your way to Las Vegas, the sparkling entertainment capital offering fun and gambling 24hrs a day! Check-in at hotel.

### Day 09 Las Vegas – Grand Canyon – Las Vegas (L)

Morning visit to the Grand Canyon, one of the natural wonders of the world. Drive back to Las Vegas. The evening is free at leisure.

### Day 10 Las Vegas – Los Angeles

Check-out at hotel. Morning visit to Ethel M Chocolate Factory and Botanical Cactus Gardens . Then stop and shop at a factory outlet en route to Los Angeles. Arrive in Los Angeles late afternoon for check-in at hotel.

### Day 11 Universal Studios – Los Angeles Airport – Manila (B)

Breakfast and Check-out at Hotel. Drive to Hollywood for a city tour. See the Walk of fame, Avenue of the Stars, Mann's Chinese Theater. Then to Universal Studios where you will take an open train through back lot that created some of the world's most famous movies. Departure transfer to the airport for you flight back to Manila or go to your onward destination.

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

**DEPOSIT AND PAYMENT REQUIREMENTS.** A deposit of FIVE HUNDRED (USD500.00) DOLLARS or its peso equivalent is required upon reservation to cover for reservations deposits required by airlines and/or tour operators. This is non-refundable and non-transferable.

Full payment of the package shall be made immediately after the issuance of the visa.

**CANCELLATION POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.** In case of cancellation, the following policies shall govern:

1. In case of visa denial, thereby effectively preventing the client from proceeding with the intended travel, the deposit shall be refunded less a minimum service deduction fee of USD200.00 to cover for operational and administrative expenses;
2. In case the participant decides to withdraw his/her participation while visa processing is still underway or after visa has been approved, the full deposit shall be forfeited in favor of BROADWAY TRAVEL, INC. to cover costs of reservation/cancellation of tour and travel arrangements, communication and other services rendered. In addition, the following cancellation charges shall apply:
  - 50% of the package price, if cancellation is made eight (8) weeks prior to departure date;
  - 75% of the package price, if cancellation is made six (6) weeks prior to departure date;
  - Full amount of the package price, if cancellation is made four (4) weeks prior to departure date.

### OTHER TERMS & CONDITIONS.
