MANILA CITY TOUR



The interesting highlights are Fort Santiago, built in 1663 inside the older Walled City of Intramuros (1591-1593) and used by the Spanish as military headquarters. San Agustin Church, the oldest stone church in the city which has a museum of religious and secular art. The Rizal Park where the remains of the country's national hero, Dr. Jose Rizal, lie within the cornerstones of the monument. Proceed to a rolling tour of scenic Roxas Boulevard fronting the Manila Bay. A visit to a curio of Filipino crafts is a must for a change in your shopping environment before driving back to your hotel.

Bahay Tsinoy is a museum of Chinese-Filipinos; the centuries relation left their impact and influences on all aspects of Philippine culture.

SAIL TO CORREGIDOR



Discover the defenses of the island fortress of Corregidor, dubbed as the "Gibraltar of the Pacific" during World War II. Long-range artilleries you have never seen before, mortars, gun emplacements, arsenals, maze of tunnels, and mile long barracks of the defiant defenders who broke the Japanese Imperial Army's timetable of conquest. Located in the mouth of Manila Bay, the Corregidor Island Group are the most formidable harbor defenses of Manila during the war. Feel the drama as it unfolds in the Malinta Tunnel Lights and Sounds Multi-vision Show. A luxurious 150-seater ferryboat will cruise you to history in just over an hour. Lunch will be served at the resort.

TAGAYTAY RIDGE TOUR



At 2,250 ft above sea level, Tagaytay Ridge offers a magnificent view of the smallest and lowest volcano in the world, Taal Volcano, resting in the middle of serene Taal Lake. A deceptive tranquility; notable are the eruptions in 1716 and 1754 where ashes spewed by the volcano darkened the skies combined with rains and thunder, massive earthquakes, and gigantic waves driving the residents around the lake to the inner towns for refuge. Visit Picnic Grove, a 13-hectare nature park with a spectacular view of the lake and volcano where optional activities like horseback riding, zipline, cable car and other activities can be experienced. Drop by People's Park in the Sky providing a picturesque 360 degrees panorama of the three provinces south of Metro Manila and westward to the sea. Lunch will be taken in a cozy restaurant overlooking Taal Volcano.

Inclusions: Roundtrip transfers, services of an English-speaking driver, lunch, entrance fees. Fees for optional activities at Picnic Grove are not included.

TAAL VOLCANO ISLAND TREKKING TOUR



Drive through the scenic countryside to the ridge of Tagaytay and down to the town of Talisay in Batangas. Upon arrival, board motorized outriggers at Taal Lake for a 30-minute boat ride to Taal Volcano, the smallest and lowest active volcano in the world. Your local guide will lead you through the trek along black sandy trails and steam vents until you reach the rim of the main crater to enjoy the spectacular views of the caldera and the crater lake. Islanders rent out horses for a minimal fee. Lunch is included.

Inclusions: Roundtrip land and boat transfers, services of an English-speaking driver, local guide, lunch.

VILLA ESCUDERO

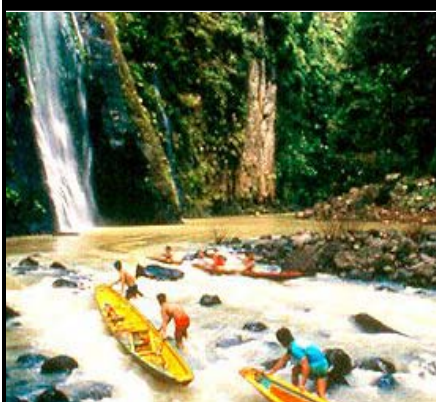


Two-and-a-half hours south of Manila is the quaint and historic Villa Escudero, amidst coconut palms, reminiscent of old plantation life. Highlight of the tour is a family museum of archaeological artifacts and private collections of antique relics from Pre-History, Spanish time and World War II. Local folks will serenade you on board water buffalo-drawn carts that transport you going to a man-made waterfalls that provides hydroelectric power to the plantation. Lunch is served on tables set over a flowing stream. On weekends (Fridays to Sundays), a cultural show is presented for the delight of plantation visitors.

Inclusions: Roundtrip transfers, services of an English-speaking driver, entrance fees, carabao cart ride, use of outdoor recreational facilities, lunch at the waterfalls.

PAGSANJAN GORGE & FALLS



A 3-hour drive to the countryside south of Manila to the old town of Pagsanjan. A riverside resort provides a "banca" (a dugout canoe) for the trip to the falls. Be prepared to get wet, water runs deep and strong in the Pagsanjan River, benevolent at times but not manageable during stormy weather when rain prods white-water mass racing downstream. At the falls, you may opt to ride a bamboo raft that will take you underneath the waterfalls to experience the thunderous cascade of water coming from 70 ft. above. Your return trip is another beguiling and thrilling boat ride experience as you "shoot the rapids" going downstream. Watch your boatman as they skillfully maneuver the boat between the rocks and boulders until you reach the calm waters of the river. Lunch follows at a riverside lodge.

Inclusions: Roundtrip transfers, services of an English-speaking driver, canoe ride, entrance fees, lunch.
