



The island of Bohol lies between Cebu and Leyte. The province is predominantly agricultural and the capital, Tagbilaran, is steeped in history. Bohol is a picturesque province replete with ancestral homes and centuries-old churches. Among the interesting places to visit on the island is the site of the blood pact between Spaniard Miguel Lopez de Legaspi and Bohol Chieftain Sikatuna which sealed their treaty of friendship. Bohol is also home to the world's smallest monkey, the Tarsier.

The Chocolate Hills remain Bohol's major attraction. About an hour and 45 minutes ride from Tagbilaran, this area consists of over a thousand haystack hills that look like giant scoops of chocolate dropped in the center of the island.

One of the newer attractions on the island is found in Danao. Take the "Plunge" at the Danao Adventure Park and experience the highest canyon swing in the world. Other eco/extreme/educational adventure offerings such as zipling, sky ride and suislide are available.

3D/2N BOHOL ESCAPADE

Day 1 - Manila-Bohol

Depart Manila for Bohol, a province steeped in history and replete with ancestral houses and centuries-old churches. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel/resort for check in and overnight. Rest of the day is free at your own leisure.

Day 2 - Bohol Countryside Tour

Breakfast at the hotel/resort. Proceed to a countryside tour of the island beginning with the historic Blood Compact Shrine, a historical landmark commemorating the 1st Treaty of Friendship between the east and the west, before visiting the centuries-old Baclayon Church and Museum. Enroute to Chocolate Hills, drive through the lush Mahogany Man-Made Forest and the green farmlands in Bilar and Batuan. In Bilar, visit a butterfly farm which showcases a variety of Philippine Butterfly species. View the awesome cone-shaped hills known as the Chocolate Hills from a viewing deck on top of one of these hills. Drive back to Loboc for a 50 minute river cruise along nipa-lined river on board a native catamaran. A sumptuous barbecue lunch is served on board. The river cruise will surely relax both your body and mind as you view nature's beauty of rolling hills, graceful coconut trees and green nipa palms lining the river banks. After the cruise, the tour then brings you back to Tagbilaran after a brief stop to see the backyard industries in Loay (nipa weaving and knife-making). Overnight stay at the hotel/resort. (B/L)

Day 3 - Bohol-Manila

After breakfast, rest of the day is free until your transfer for your flight back to Manila. (B)

Day 1 - Manila-Cebu

Depart Manila for Cebu. Proceed to a tour of Cebu City which traces its rich historical past. Visit Fort San Pedro - oldest Spanish fort, Magellan's Cross, Sto. Nino Basilica - home of the oldest religious relic image of the Baby Jesus, Cebu Metropolitan Cathedral, Jesuit House, Museo Sugbu, Taoist Temple, Taboan Dried Market, Mactan Shrine, Guitar Factory, Otap factory and dried mangoes. Check in at the hotel/resort for overnight.

Day 2 - Cebu-Bohol-Cebu

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the seaport for your trip to historical and scenic Bohol. This tour brings you to the Blood Compact Shrine, a historical landmark commemorating the 1st Treaty of Friendship between the east and the west, before visiting the centuries-old Baclayon Church & Museum. Drive through the lush Mahogany Man-Made forest and green farmlands in Bilar and Batuan. View the awesome cone-shaped hills known as Chocolate Hills from a viewing deck on top of one of these hills. 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OPTIONAL TOURS IN BOHOL

PAMILACAN MARINE LIFE TOUR W/DOLPHIN WATCHING

An early morning boat trip to the seawaters southeast of Tagbilaran City on board a motorized outrigger boat. The seawaters around Pamilacan Island is home to at least six (6) species of whales and dolphins. If you are lucky, these whales may be sighted between February to August. Also, residents in the area are different species of dolphins.

It may be interesting to note that the crew and spotters for this tour are the former whale hunters, now trained "spotters" who gave up their traditional livelihood in favor of preserving the environment.

Other activities in this tour includes swimming and snorkeling around Pamilacan Island, a village tour and picnic lunch.

TAGBILARAN HALF-DAY CITY TOUR

Tagbilaran City, the capital city of Bohol. A fast-growing city of about 120,000 people, the seat of education in the island and the center of commerce.

Moving around the city by public transport - the three (3) wheeled "tricycle" can be an interesting experience. The central market displays the agricultural and marine products of the province.

Across the town plaza is the St. Joseph Cathedral, originally built in 1767 by the Jesuit mission. Although the structure has been renovated, the original silver pieces in its altar are well-preserved and still being used. Across the cathedral is another old Spanish-built edifice which now houses government offices. Within walking distance is the Bohol National Museum which displays historical artifacts of the province.

Other points of interest are the Governor's Mansion, the fish port, "Old Tagbilaran" ancestral houses, antique shops and souvenir shops showcasing Boholano products.

BOHOL HERITAGE TOUR

This trip showcases the rich historical and cultural heritage of the Boholanos. This will bring you to magnificent old churches of Loon and Maribojoc built during the Spanish regime, centuries back, in baroque and gothic literature. The church in Dauis, built in Romanesque design, this religious edifice has a characteristically thinner walls as compared to thick-walled churches like Baclayon Church. Its well-preserved ceiling paintings are a sight to behold. Next destination is Baclayon Church, one of the oldest stone churches in the country. This church is home to the newly restored bamboo organ and museum that showcases an extraordinary collection of antique ecclesiastical vestments and paraphernalia, religious arts and a vast assortment of 16th century church relics and artifacts.

A visit to Clarin Heritage House in Loay offers tourists a glimpse of Boholano middle-class lifestyle. The house shows antique household items and furnishings. In the same town, traditional backyard industries such as nipa weaving and blacksmithing (specifically for farm tools and knives) can still be observed. The making of calamay, a local delicacy, could be seen among its makers in Albur. Baclayon is also home to broas which are prepared in the traditional way.

DANAO ADVENTURE TOUR

This tour offers medium to hard adventure activities which includes kayaking, river tubing, rappelling and caving. Trained local adventure guides will handle the guests in the area. Package includes basic equipment and picnic lunch.
