5D/4N TOKYO & MT. FUJI



TENTATIVE ITINERARY

Day 1 Manila-Tokyo

Depart Manila for the flight to Narita. Upon arrival, transfer to Diver City Shopping Mall. After dinner at local restaurant, proceed to the hotel for check-in and overnight. (D)

Day 2 Tokyo-Mt. Fuji

Breakfast at the hotel. Pass by the beautiful Imperial Palace East Garden, then Tokyo Tower for a brief photo stop. Proceed to Mt. Fuji and enjoy a cruise at Lake Ashi to marvel at the beauty of nature. Next is the shopping haven of Gotemba Premium Outlet for premium brands like Nike, Prada, Banana Republic, GAP, Salvatore Ferragamo, Puma, Gucci, Coach, Bulgari, Ralph Lauren, Ray-Ban, Alexander Wang, Balenciaga and many more. After shopping, we shall proceed to the hotel to check-in and experience the Onsen (hot spring bath) to relieve yourself of stress and revitalize both body and mind. (B/L/D)

Day 3 Mt. Fuji-Tokyo

After breakfast and check-out, proceed to Fuji-Q Highland Theme Park, Japan's most famous amusement park at the foot of Mt. Fuji with about 40 different attractions. Then on to Fujiko Museum, also informally known as the Doraemon Museum, a fanciful art museum found in the suburbs of Kawasaki. It is based on the work of Fujiko F. Fujio (nom de plume of manga artist Fujimoto Hiroshi) who is the creator of Doraemon, an influential series about a robotic cat from the 22nd century who travels back in time to befriend a group of kids. Then visit Hachiko Statue and Shibuya Crossing. Walk deeper into the world-famous Ginza Shopping District (where 12 floors of Uniqlo is located). Afterwards we will have Yakiniku Buffet before proceeding to the hotel for check-in and overnight. (B/L/D)

Day 4 Tokyo

After breakfast, proceed to Japan Disneyland or Disney Sea for a whole day of fun and excitement at "the happiest place on earth". Return to the hotel at the end of the day. (B)

Day 5 Departure to Manila

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. We head next to Earthquake Experience where we will learn about earthquake safety guidelines and preparation. Then on to Asakusa Temple, Japan's oldest temple completed in 645 AD. Nearby is Nakamise shopping street which leads from the outer gate to the temple's second gate called Hozomon. Time for some last minute shopping at Aeon Mall before flying back to Manila. (B)
