



The island of Bohol lies between Cebu and Leyte. The province is predominantly agricultural and the capital, Tagbilaran, is steeped in history. Bohol is a picturesque province replete with ancestral homes and centuries-old churches. Among the interesting places to visit on the island is the site of the blood pact between Spaniard Miguel Lopez de Legaspi and Bohol Chieftain Sikatuna which sealed their treaty of friendship. Bohol is also home to the world's smallest monkey, the Tarsier.

The Chocolate Hills remain Bohol's major attraction. About an hour and 45 minutes ride from Tagbilaran, this area consists of over a thousand haystack hills that look like giant scoops of chocolate dropped in the center of the island.

One of the newer attractions on the island is found in Danao. Take the "Plunge" at the Danao Adventure Park and experience the highest canyon swing in the world. Other eco/extreme/educational adventure offerings such as zipling, sky ride and suislides are available.

TENTATIVE ITINERARY

Day 1 - Manila-Bohol

Depart Manila for Bohol, a province steeped in history and replete with ancestral houses and centuries-old churches. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel/resort for check in and overnight. Rest of the day is free at your own leisure.

Day 2 - Bohol Countryside Tour

Breakfast at the hotel/resort. Proceed to a countryside tour of the island beginning with the historic Blood Compact Shrine, a historical landmark commemorating the 1st Treaty of Friendship between the east and the west, before visiting the centuries-old Baclayon Church and Museum. Enroute to Chocolate Hills, drive through the lush Mahogany Man-Made Forest and the green farmlands in Bilar and Batuan. In Bilar, visit a butterfly farm which showcases a variety of Philippine Butterfly species. View the awesome cone-shaped hills known as the Chocolate Hills from a viewing deck on top of one of these hills. Drive back to Loboc for a 50 minute river cruise along nipa-lined river on board a native catamaran. A sumptuous barbecue lunch is served on board. The river cruise will surely relax both your body and mind as you view nature's beauty of rolling hills, graceful coconut trees and green nipa palms lining the river banks. After the cruise, the tour then brings you back to Tagbilaran after a brief stop to see the backyard industries in Loay (nipa weaving and knife-making). Overnight stay at the hotel/resort. (B/L)
