



VILLA ESCUDERO



Two-and-a-half hours south of Manila is the quaint and historic Villa Escudero, amidst coconut palms, reminiscent of old plantation life. Highlight of the tour is a family museum of archaeological artifacts and private collections of antique relics from Pre-History, Spanish time and World War II. Local folks will serenade you on board carabao-drawn carts that transport you going to a man-made waterfalls that provides hydroelectric power to the plantation. Lunch is served on tables set over a flowing stream (weather-permitting). The Philippine Experience Show showcasing the country's rich culture that has been preserved by traditional dances and music is presented for the delight of plantation visitors. Rates below are not valid on holidays.

SAIL TO CORREGIDOR



Discover the defenses of the island fortress of Corregidor, dubbed as the "Gibraltar of the Pacific" during World War II. Long-range artilleries you have never seen before, mortars, gun emplacements, arsenals, maze of tunnels, and mile long barracks of the defiant defenders who broke the Japanese Imperial Army's timetable of conquest. Located in the mouth of Manila Bay, the Corregidor Island Group are the most formidable harbor defenses of Manila during the war. Feel the drama as it unfolds in the Malinta Tunnel Lights and Sounds Multi-vision Show. A fully air-conditioned business class vessel will cruise you to history in just over an hour. Lunch is included. 2023 sailing/tour dates are pre-scheduled by Corregidor Foundation and are subject to change without prior notice.

PAGSANJAN GORGE & FALLS



A 3-hour drive to the countryside south of Manila to the old town of Pagsanjan. A riverside resort provides a "banca" (a dugout canoe) for the trip to the falls. Be prepared to get wet, water runs deep and strong in the Pagsanjan River, benevolent at times but not manageable during stormy weather when rain prods white-water mass racing downstream. At the falls, you may opt to ride a bamboo raft that will take you underneath the waterfalls to experience the thunderous cascade of water coming from 70 ft. above. Your return trip is another beguiling and thrilling boat ride experience as you "shoot the rapids" going downstream. Watch your boatmen as they skillfully maneuver the boat between the rocks and boulders until you reach the calm waters of the river. Lunch follows at a riverside lodge.
