



## PILGRIMAGE ITINERARY

**Day 01** Depart Manila for Amman, Jordan

Depart Hong Kong on a prestigious airline for an overnight flight to Amman. Enjoy the services and entertainment on board the flight. Upon arrival in Amman, meet and assist at the airport. Drive to the hotel for check-in, dinner and overnight. (D)

Amman-Petra-Amman

Breakfast at the hotel. Drive to Petra. Get a glimpse of what was once the biblical land. Travel along the Desert Highway through the ever-changing scenery of the Transjordan plateau. In Petra, visit the fabled rose City of Petra, the 2,000 year old Nabatean capital accidentally rediscovered in 1812. Walk through the Siq, a half mile long unforgettable gorge. Experience the "Indiana Jones" film. At last, you stand in awe in front of the Treasury, a wonder of the world – a rose colored monumental building artfully carved out of sheer rock. Travel back to Amman for dinner and overnight. (B/L/D)

Amman-Madaba-Allenby Border-Jericho-Dead Sea-Nazareth Day 03

Breakfast at the hotel and check out. Depart Amman and drive to Madaba to visit the Monastery of Saint George which hosts the unique mosaic map of Egypt, Jordan and the Holy Land. The map is believed to be the first one for this area, built in the 6<sup>th</sup> century A.D. Continue your journey to Mount Nebo where Moses viewed the Promised Land before he died. Continue the journey crossing the Allenby Border towards the Holy Land. Proceed to the old city of Jericho where Jesus called out Roundtrip economy class air-ticket Tacchaeus, a tax collector, to climb down a sycamore tree. From a distance, also view Mount of Hotel accommodations on twin sharing

Temptation where Jesus was tempted. Later on, enjoy a dip or float on the Dead Sea (if weather Meals: B-breakfast / L-lunch / D-dinner as specified permits). Continue driving to Nazareth for check-in, dinner and overnight. (B/L/D)

Continue on to Capernaum, the town where Jesus made His home after leaving Nazaretti. view the remains of the Aller Spragogue in which He taught. On to Tabgha where the Miracle of the Multiplication of Pilgrimage Chaplain Loaves and Fishes took place, then visit St. Peter's Primacy Church. Drive to Mount of Beatitudes Pilgrimage Chaplain Services of a Tour Director Services of a Tour Director Travel Insurance (up to 70 years old) Travel Insurance (up to 70 years old) Capernaum, the town where Jesus made His home after leaving Nazareth. View the remains of the

Day 05 Nazareth-Haifa-Caesarea-Bethlehem

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Visit the Basilica of the Annunciation where the angel Gabriel announced to the Virgin Mary that she would conceive and give birth to Jesus Christ. Visit also St. Joseph's Workshop. Proceed to the nearby town of Cana where Jesus performed His first miracle when He turned water into wine at the wedding feast in Cana (married couples may wish to renew their wedding yows at the church). Travel to Haifa to see the Basilica of Mount Carmel and the cave of Prophet Elijah. Then drive through Caesarea which was built by Herod the Great to visit the aqueducts and the old crusader city. In Bethlehem, visit a store where you can buy olive wooden rosaries, crucifixes, and other souvenir items. Check-in at the hotel for dinner & overnight. (B/L/D)

Day 06 Bethlehem-Mt. of Olives-Bethlehem

After breakfast, proceed to the Mount of Olives. Visit the Ascension Chapel where Jesus ascended into Heaven. Then witness the "Lord's Prayer" written in several languages at the Church of Pater Noster. Walk down the Palm Sunday Road and stop at the Church of Dominus Flevit where Jesus Prophesized the destruction of Jerusalem and wept. Continue by walking down to the Church of All Nations or the Basilica of the Agony located next to the Garden of Gethsemane, the place where Jesus prayed before His passion. Proceed to the nearby Tomb of Virgin Mary, the burial place of the Mother of our Lord Jesus. Also visit the Western Wall. Then on to Bethlehem to visit the Church of the Nativity (birthplace of Jesus). Back to the hotel for dinner and overnight. (B/L/D)

Bethlehem-Jerusalem (Via Dolorosa)-Mt. Zion-Ein Kerem-Bethlehem

Breakfast at the hotel. Enter the Old City of Jerusalem. Visit the Church of St. Anne and the Pools of Bethesda. Walk the Via Dolorosa starting at the Ecce Homo where Pontius Pilate washed his hands. Proceed to the Flagellation and go through all the Stations of the Cross until you reach the Church of the Holy Sepulcher where Jesus was crucified, died and rose from the dead. Visit the Mount Zion area to see the Last Supper Room where Jesus and His disciples had their last supper and where the descent of the Holy Spirit took place. See also King David's Tomb and the Dormition Abbey. Then stop by the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu, the house of the High Priest Caiaphas where St. Peter denied Jesus three times. Also visit the Wailing Wall. Drive to Ein Kerem to see the birthplace and Church of Saint John the Baptist and to the Church of Visitation where the Blessed Virgin Mary visited her cousin, Elizabeth and proclaimed the "Magnificat". Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight. (B/L/D)

Day 08 Bethlehem-Eilat-Taba Border Crossing-Dahab
Breakfast at the hotel and check out. Visit the Shepherds' Field where an angel brought the tidings of joy to some shepherds that the long-awaited savior had been born. Drive past the Arava Desert, Qumran mountains and Dead Sea on your way to the Egyptian border. After immigration formalities, continue with the journey across the Sinai Desert to your hotel by the Red Sea from where you may join an overnight climb of Mt. Sinal where Moses received the Ten Commandments (shuttle departs from Dahab to St. Catherine in the evening, weather permitting). Check in at the hotel for dinner and overnight. (B/L/D)

Dahab-St. Catherine-Cairo

For those who will join the climb of Mt. Sinai, it usually takes around 8 to 10 hours to complete After the climb, wait for the rest of the group from Dahab to arrive at St. Catherine Monastery for a short visit (if open). Enjoy the long drive through the desert with tunnel crossing under the Suez Canal to Cairo. Finally, arrive at the city of Cairo and check-in at the hotel for overnight. (B/L/D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Start the day by seeing one of the wonders of the world, the Pyramids of Giza and the nearby Sphinx. Drop by a perfumery factory and enjoy the natural essences of Egypt. Visit Old Cairo and see St. Virgin Mary's Coptic Church, commonly called the Hanging Church because it was built on top of one of the Roman towers. Also see the Church of St. Sergius (Abu Serga) which was built above the cave where the Holy Family rested at the end of their journey into Egypt. Proceed to shops where you can buy papyrus (the first paper in the world), cotton, linen, silk and other souvenir items. Enjoy a cruise on the River Nile with dinner and folkloric show and feel the time of Cleopatra. Return to the hotel for overnight. (B/L/D)

Cairo-Manila **Day 11** 

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Be educated about Egyptian history at the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization, home to a collection of ancient Egyptian artifacts from the time of the Pharaohs, including mummies of ancient kings and queens of Egypt. Finally, visit and pray at the place of the apparition of the Virgin Mary (1968) at Zeitoun before heading to the airport for flight back home. (B/L)
