Delhi-Agra-Jaipur



TOUR ITINERARY

Day 1 Manila-Delhi

Depart Manila for your flight to India. On arrival, you will be greeted and assisted by our representative and transferred to the hotel.

Day 2 Delhi

After breakfast, enjoy a full day sightseeing tour of Delhi. Visit the Red Fort (from the outside), built starting in 1638 on the western bank of the river Yamuna. The great mosque of Jama Masjid, the largest in India, has a courtyard capable of holding 25,000 devotees. Enjoy a rickshaw ride (paddy cab) around Jama Masjid and through the narrow streets of Old Delhi. Photos stop at the 42m high India Gate, an "Arc-de-Triumph" like archway at the center of Delhi commemorating the 70,000 Indian soldiers who lost their lives fighting for the British Army during World War I. Drive by several government buildings and official residences reminiscent of the British colonial architecture such as the Parliament House and Rashtrapati Bhawan, the official residence of the President of India. Visit the magnificent Humayun Tomb, the most notable features of which are the garden squares (Charbagh) with pathways, water channels, and a centrally located mausoleum topped by a double dome. Dinner and overnight at the hotel. (B/D)

Day 3 Delhi-Agra

After breakfast, enjoy the long drive to Agra (around 210 kms or 4 1/2 hours drive), the city of the inimitable Taj Mahal. In the afternoon, visit the massive Agra Fort commissioned by the great Mughal Emperor Akbar in 1666 with its exquisite buildings such as the Moti Masjid, Diwan-I-Am, Diwan-I-Khaas, Musamman Burj, Jahangir's Palace, Khaas Mahal and Shish Mahal. Dinner and overnight at the hotel. (B/D)

Day 4 Agra-Abhaneri-Jaipur

Enjoy sunrise visit of Taj Mahal, a white marble mausoleum built by Mughal Emperor Shahjahan as a memorial to his beloved wife Mumtaz Mahal. A world-renowned wonder, the Taj Mahal looks the same from all four sides and is phenomenal not in its beauty alone but also in the deep planning and design that went into its making. It was built in 1631 and took 22 years to complete. Return to the hotel for breakfast, then check-out and drive to Abhaneri to visit the one of the largest step wells in the world, the Chand Baori (Step Well), built by King Chanda sometime in the 9th century in the Abhaneri Village of Rajasthan. Continue the drive to Jaipur (around 235 kms or 5 1/2 hours drive from Agra), the fascinating capital of the marvelous state of Rajasthan. Check-in, dinner and overnight at the hotel in Jaipur. (B/D)

Day 5 Jaipur

Proceed on a sightseeing tour of Jaipur after breakfast. Visit Amber Fort, built by Raja Man Singh I in 1592 on picturesque and rugged hills in a fascinating blend of Hindu and Mughal architecture. Enjoy an elephant ride at Amber Fort like the royalty of Rajasthan once did. Mount the animal from a raised platform and sit comfortably in a specially designed, secure seat as the majestic animal winds its way up the ramparts of the fort. Continue the tour of Jaipur with a visit at the City Palace, a blend of Mughal and Rajput architecture where members of the ex-royal family still lives in a part of the palace. Photo stop at Hawa Mahal Palace, easily the most well-known landmark and icon of Jaipur overlooking the busy bazaar street. Finally, visit the Jantar Mantar, a collection of architectural astronomical instruments built by Maharaja Jai Singh II between 1727 and 1734. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight. (B/D)

Day 6 Jaipur-Delhi

After breakfast, check-out and drive back to Delhi (around 260 kms or 6 hours drive). On arrival in Delhi, proceed to the international airport for your flight back to Manila. (B)

DEPOSIT AND PAYMENT REQUIREMENTS. A deposit of FIVE HUNDRED (USD500.00) DOLLARS or its peso equivalent is required upon reservation to cover for reservations deposits required by airlines and/or tour operators. This is non-refundable and non-transferable.

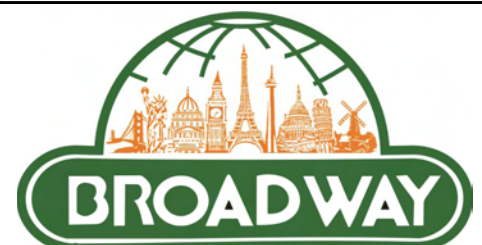
Full payment of the package shall be made on the option date imposed by such airline or tour operator but not later than two (2) months before departure.

CANCELLATION POLICIES AND GUIDELINES. In case of cancellation, the following policies shall govern:

1. In case of cancellation of the tour due to lack of participants, the tour will be moved to a later date and all deposits and payments already made will be fully credited without any additional charges.
2. In case the participant decides to withdraw his/her participation after registration, the full deposit shall be forfeited in favor of BROADWAY TRAVEL, INC. to cover costs of reservation/cancellation of tour and travel arrangements, communication and other services rendered. In addition, the following cancellation charges shall apply:
 - 50% of the package price, if cancellation is made eight (8) weeks prior to departure date;
 - 75% of the package price, if cancellation is made six (6) weeks prior to departure date;
 - Full amount of the package price, if cancellation is made four (4) weeks prior to departure date.
