DAY 01 Manila – Siem Reap (D)

Meet and greet with our local friendly and experienced guide upon arrival at Siem Reap International Airport. Then transfer to hotel for check in. Dinner will be served at a local restaurant. Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 02 Siem Reap (B/L/D)

After breakfast, transfer to visit the lost city of Khmer Empire, South Gate of Angkor Thom, Giant faces of famous Bayon and Baphoun Temples, Elephant and Leper King Terraces, Phimean Akas Temple and unforgettable jungle temple of Ta Prohm. Lunch will be served in a local restaurant. Afternoon program includes a visit to the World Heritage site of Angkor Wat Temple. Study both splendid architecture and bas-relief and then late evening climb up the Bakheng Hill to enjoy sunset scenery view over Angkor Wat and the surrounding areas. Dinner will be served in a local restaurant. Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 03 Siem Reap (B/L/D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Visit Western Baray, which was the water reservoir built since Angkoian era and still in use for agriculture today. Near here, visit Artisans D' Angkor of silk worm breeding and raising center where young people are in the process of learning these skills. The on to the War Museum where there is a large collection of guns, rifles, rocket launchers, pistols, mortars, grenades, CS gas canisters, bombs, and bullets all recovered from the countryside of Cambodia that was left behind by the war in Cambodia in the past. Lunch will be served in a local restaurant. In the afternoon, visit the floating and fishing villages in Tonle Sap Great Lake, which is one of the world's most productive bodies of fresh water. Each year, millions of fish come to spawn in the seasonally flooded forest surrounding the lake, attracting myriad of water birds as well as people who have settled in villages along the shores and who live with the rhythms of the water. This ecosystem of extraordinary biological richness and balance between humans and nature was recently designated as a Biosphere Reserve by UNESCO. It is this fusion of water and forest, this dense and intertwined world of fish, birds and people which we invite you to immerse yourself in. Back to town to visit Artisans D' Angkor (wood and stone carving) where you will discover the traditional Khmer techniques used for stone and wood carving and leisure for shopping at local market. Dinner will be served at a local restaurant with classical dance show. Overnight at the hotel.

DAY 04 Siem Reap - Manila

Breakfast at the hotel. Free time at leisure until check out for departure transfer to the airport for your flight back to Manila.
