France, Spain, Portugal, Monaco & Italy

November 10-29, 2012



Day 01 MANILA / PARIS

Depart Manila on board a prestigious airline on your way to Rome, Italy. Enjoy in flights meals and entertainment on board.

Day 02 / PARIS (D)

Welcome to Paris! After airport formalities, meet and greet then board your motor coach and transfer to your hotel. Rest of the day is free.

Day 03 PARIS (B, D)

Go on a half day guided tour of Paris. See the Arc de Triomphe, Champs Elysees, the Concorde Square, Louvre Museum, the Place Vendome, the Opera House, Notre Dame Cathedral, the Eiffel Tower plus enjoy the famous River Seine Bateaux Mouche Cruise. Rest of the day is free.

Day 04 PARIS - NEVERS - PARAY LE MONIAL (B, D)

After breakfast, drive to Nevers to visit the Church of St. Gildard to see the uncorrupted body of Saint Bernadette. Then continue to the beautiful town of Paray Le Monial for your overnight. Some free time to visit the Chapel of Visitation where St. Marguerite-Marie Alacoque saw the apparition of the Heart of Jesus.

Day 05 PARAY LE MONIAL - TOULOUSE (B, D)

After breakfast, drive to the Metropolitan City of Toulouse for your overnight at the hotel. Some free time to explore the city.

Day 06 TOULOUSE - LOURDES (B, D)

After breakfast, drive to the major pilgrimage site of Europe, Lourdes. The whole day is free for private devotion. You may wish to go to the Sanctuary to visit the Underground Basilica, walk the Station of the Cross, take the Holy Bath, or participate in the Veneration of the Sick Pilgrims. In the evening, buy a candle and join the Candlelight Procession.

Day 07 LOURDES - LOYOLA - BURGOS (B, D)

After breakfast, cross the Spanish border and stop in Loyola for an orientation tour. Afterwards, continue to Burgos for dinner and overnight.

Day 08 BURGOS - SALAMANCA - FATIMA (B, D)

After breakfast, continue your drive to Salamanca for photos of the beautiful Plaza Mayor. Then travel over the Portuguese border on your way to Fatima, another major pilgrimage center. Upon arrival, check-in at hotel and rest of the day is free.

Day 09 FATIMA (B, D)

Free day for private devotion. You may spend the day in meditating at the Chapel of Apparition, the very heart of the Sanctuary.

Day 10 FATIMA - AVILA - MADRID (B, D)

After breakfast, travel back to Spain on your way to Avila, the City of Kings and Saints, completely encircled by 11th century walls and the birthplace of St. Therese, one of the greatest mystics of the Catholic church, then continue to Madrid for your overnight.

Day 11 MADRID - ZARAGOSA - BARCELONA (B, D)

After breakfast, drive to Zaragoza to visit the Shrine of our Lady of the Pillar. Continue to the city of Barcelona for dinner and overnight.

Day 12 BARCELONA (B, D)

Morning half-day guided city tour featuring the Columbus Monument, the elegant tree-lined Ramblas, the Plaza de Catalonia, the historic building along the Paseo de Gracia, a panoramic view of the city and harbour from Montjuich Hill and the controversial Sagrada Familia Basilica. In the afternoon, drive to Montserrat to visit the Monastery.

Day 13 BARCELONA - NICE (B, D)

After breakfast, drive through the sun-drenched landscaped of Van Gogh's beloved Provence until you reach Nice, the "Queen of the Riviera". Check in to your hotel upon arrival.

Day 14 NICE - MONTE CARLO - PISA (B, D)

After breakfast, visit the perfume factory in Eze where the area is famous. Then drive to the nearby Principality of Monaco to see the Royal Palace and Annunciation Cathedral where Princess Grace was buried in Monte Carlo. Then cross the Italian Border on your way to Pisa for overnight.

Day 15 PISA - ROME (B, D)

After breakfast, drive to the famous Leaning Tower of Pisa and Cathedral and continue to the eternal city of Rome for Check-in.

Day 16 ROME (B, D)

This morning proceed to St. Peter's Square. Then visit the four major basilicas of Rome: St. Peter's Basilica, Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Wall, Basilica of St. John in Lateran and the Sta. Maria Maggiore Basilica. Some free time to explore the city.

Day 17 ROME - ASSISI - PADOVA (B, D)

After breakfast, drive to Assisi, the town of St. Francis. Walk through the hilly, maze like streets and feel the medieval settings of this historic place. Visit the Upper and Lower Basilica and appreciate the artistic and historical significance of this unique church. Then drive to Padova for overnight.

Day 18 PADOVA - MILAN (B, D)

After breakfast, visit the Basilica San Antonio in Padova. Then continue to Milan the fashion city of Italy. Visit the Duomo Cathedral. Free time to explore the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II Arcade for shopping.

Day 19 MILAN / MANILA (B)

Your memorable tour concludes today with a transfer to the airport for your flight back to Manila.





ITINERARY / PROGRAM

DAY 01 MANILA/MUNICH

Depart Manila on board a prestigious airline on your way to Munich, Germany. Enjoy inflight meals and services.

DAY 02 MUNICH (D)

Welcome to Munich. After immigration formalities, proceed to the exit for meet and greet then check in to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 03 MUNICH-NUREMBERG (B/D)

This morning, discover the sights of Munich such as the world-famous Hofbrauhaus, the National Theater with the Royal Palace, Marienplatz and the Viktualien Market with its colorful outdoor stalls. Later, travel to Nuremberg, Bavaria's second largest city. Upon arrival, go on an orientation tour to learn more about this beautiful city. Then check in to your hotel.

DAY 04 NUREMBERG-PRAGUE (B/D)

After breakfast, cross over the Czech border on your way to one of Europe's most beautiful cities, Prague. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel. Rest of the day is free.

DAY 05 PRAGUE (B/D)

Today, your city tour will take you to some of the most interesting attractions of Prague such as the Old Royal Castle which includes the Vladislav Hall, the St. Georges Basilica, Rosenberg Palace and the Powder Tower. Also, visit St. Vitus Cathedral, the seat of the Archbishop of Prague and the most important church in the country. Afterwards, visit the Golden Lane and Daliborka Tower. On the list is also a visit to Charles Bridge and the Astronomical Clock, situated at the Old Town Hall where you can shop for some Bohemian Crystals.

DAY 06 PRAGUE-DRESDEN-BERLIN (B/D)

Cross to Germany to the City of Dresden to see the Frauenkirche, Germany's most important Protestant church before admiring the Procession of Dukes - a colossal mosaic on the Castle Wall. See the cathedral and the tiered façade of the Semper Opera House - the only theatre in Germany that bears the name of its architect. Proceed to Berlin for check in to your hotel.

DAY 07 BERLIN (B/D)

We'll commence our city tour of Berlin with a visit to the Brandenburg Gate, Unter Den Linden Boulevard, German State Opera House and Reichstag Building. Visit the city's history which is particularly vivid as presented by the pictures at the Wall Museum at "Checkpoint Charlie". Dinner and overnight in Berlin.

DAY 08 BERLIN-WARSAW (B/D)

Breakfast at the hotel, and then travel over the Polish border on your way to Warsaw, the country's capital. Upon arrival, transfer to a local restaurant for dinner. Then check in to your hotel.

DAY 09 WARSAW (B/D)

Drive to Lazienki Park and see the Palace in the Water, intended to serve as a bathhouse, habitable pavilion and a garden grotto. Later, visit the Ghetto Memorial, the memorial commemorating the 1943 uprising in the Warsaw Ghetto, and the Old Town. Balance of the day is free at leisure. After dinner, transfer back to your hotel.

DAY 10 WARSAW-CZESTOCHOWA-AUSCHWITZ-KRAKOW (B/D)

We will visit Jasna Gora, the monastery in Czestochowa, and see the image of the Black Madonna which is venerated as the "Queen of Poland" and has become the country's national symbol. Continue your visit to Auschwitz and Birkenau Museum, chilling reminders of the Holocaust. Dinner and overnight.

DAY 11 KRAKOW (B/D)

After breakfast, go on a full day sightseeing tour that starts with a drive to Lagiewniki to visit the Shrine of the Divine Mercy of Sister Faustina. Then continue to the Old Town. After lunch break, visit the famous Wieliczka Saltmines, a centuries old tourist attraction.

DAY 12 KRAKOW-BUDAPEST (B/D)

After breakfast, drive to Wadowice, small city of about 20,000 some 30 miles southwest of Krakow, has got international recognition as the birthplace of Pope John Paul II, born in 1920 as Karol Wojtyła. Then drive across the Hungarian border on your way to the twin city of Budapest. Upon arrival, check in to your hotel. Rest of the day is free.

DAY 13 BUDAPEST (B)

After breakfast, go on a city sightseeing tour which includes Heroes Square, a visit to the Fishermen's Bastion and see the Matyas Templon (St. Matthias Church). Balance of the day will be free for shopping.

DAY 14 BUDAPEST-VIENNA (B)

Breakfast at the hotel before crossing the border of Austria. Upon arrival in Vienna, visit Schonbrunn Palace, the palace and gardens illustrate the tastes, interests, and aspirations of successive Habsburg monarchs. View the Hofburg, Opera and Rathaus. Some free time to explore the Old Town before checking in to your hotel.

DAY 15 VIENNA / MANILA

After breakfast, some free time until your departure transfer to the airport for flight back to Manila.

DAY 16 MANILA

Arrival in Manila. Home Sweet Home!


