



Cavite abounds with great objects, and subjects, of culture and history. It is the birthplace of a good number of Filipino heroes and it has an interesting range of sites associated with the Philippine Revolution of 1896. Found in the province is the residence of the first president of the republic, Emilio Aguinaldo, which is also the site where the Philippine Republic was proclaimed on June 12, 1898.

Cavite teems with natural resources and fantastic landscapes. It is home to Tagaytay City, the Philippines' second summer capital, next to Baguio City. The accessing highway offers a breathtaking sight of the world-famous Taal formation, a crater within an island within a lake. Coconut groves dot the ridges of Tagaytay and classy accommodations give the visiting tourists the pleasures of relaxation, and at the same time, wide opportunities to enjoy the magnificent view of Taal.

Yet Cavite stands proudly as a place with a glorious past. Its warm and friendly people, whose ancestors fought for a noble cause, manifest industry and patience in various skills and professions, openly receptive to the entry and exchange of culture and technology that are of value to this wondrous province.

3D/2N CAVITE-BATANGAS-LAGUNA COMBINATION

Day 1 - Manila-Tagaytay

Morning departure from Manila to Tagaytay. Proceed to a tour of Tagaytay Ridge which offers a magnificent view of the smallest and lowest volcano in the world, Taal Volcano, resting in the middle of serene Taal Lake. A deceptive tranquility; notable are the eruptions in 1716 and 1754 where ashes spewed by the volcano darkened the skies combined with rains and thunder, massive earthquakes, and gigantic waves driving the residents around the lake to the inner towns for refuge. The 1911 eruption claimed 1,300 lives, and 300 more in 1965 burying 6 barrios. Visit People's Park in the Sky providing a picturesque 360 degrees view of the three provinces south of Metro Manila and westward to the sea. The tour also provides a visit to GBR Museum which houses more than 3,000 vintage paintings and photographs of the Philippines, antique maps and imperial glass pieces from China and other vintage articles. Lunch will be taken in a cozy restaurant overlooking the lake & the volcano. Check-in at the hotel for overnight. (L)

Day 2 - Tagaytay-Taal Trekking-Tagaytay

Breakfast at the hotel. Drive down to the town of Talisay in Batangas, the jump-off point to Taal Volcano. Upon arrival, board motorized outriggers to the island volcano 30 minutes away. Light trekkers can view the caldera from the rim of the crater. Islanders are renting out horses for minimal fee. Strong trekkers can hike through the expanse of hardened black lava up to an easy incline and down to the crater for a close-up view of the caldera. The lake inside the crater invites hikers to a relaxing swim. Return to a shoreline resort for a sumptuous lunch. Return to Tagaytay for overnight. (B/L)

Day 3 - Tagaytay-Villa Escudero-Manila

After breakfast, check-out of the hotel and proceed to the quaint and historic Villa Escudero, amidst coconut palms, reminiscent of old plantation life. Highlight of the tour is a family museum of archaeological artifacts and private collections of antique relics from Pre-History, Spanish time and World War II. Local folks will serenade you on board water buffalo-drawn carts that transport you going to a man-made waterfalls that provides hydroelectric power to the plantation. Lunch is served on tables set over a flowing stream. On weekends, a cultural show is presented for the delight of plantation visitors. Return to Manila after the tour for your next destination. (B/L)
